Mark your calendar and plan to participate in our Festival of Trees Week. The event is scheduled Nov. 28–Dec. 3, 2022 in our clubhouse. This is a fundraiser for our park that will provide a Christmas atmosphere in the clubhouse and generate income.

Thurs Dec 1st - Salad luncheon at noon \$5 per person. We need salad donations

Sat Dec 3rd - Park breakfast

As you can see, there are many ways to participate. You can volunteer to help in the clubhouse during the event, provide baked goods for the bake sale, decorate a tree or wreath, donate decorations, donate funds to purchase trees or donate a salad. There will be sign up sheets in the clubhouse.

Christmas Trees and Wreaths. Help decorate artificial Christmas trees for our Festival of Trees. Nov 26 – 27 will be designated as “tree trimming days”. We will be decorating 2 to 4 foot Christmas trees, provided by the park. We ask the decorators to donate the decorations. The trees will be on display November 28 through Dec 3 from 9 am to 5 pm in the clubhouse for visitors to view and bid on their favorite tree or wreath. Bids will close on December 3, 2021 at noon. High bidder will pick up and pay for the tree they bid on.

- Decorate a pre-lit miniature Christmas tree or wreath. Individuals or groups can collaborate to trim a tree.
- Decorate your tree in advance or on the designated “tree-trimming days”. If you choose to decorate in advance the trees will be available to pick up at the

clubhouse on November 12th from 10 am to noon and should be ready for display on November 26th.

- If you don’t want to decorate a tree but would like to contribute Christmas decorations or funds to purchase decorations we have a team of people willing to decorate a tree on your behalf.

We want this to be a park activity and welcome everyone to contribute or participate. We encourage you to sign up now so we have an idea of how many trees we need. There is a sign up sheet in the clubhouse or you can complete the form found on our website and e-mail it to dri76ski@comcast.net.

We feel this event will bring shoppers from other parks as well as our own. We plan to advertise “Golfview Festival of Trees Week” with flyers in other parks, on Facebook and Nextdoor, If you have suggestions contact Sandi Ivey or Phyllis McGroarty.
